Volunteer Day – Last Thursday of the Month

In response to the many people who have called wanting to volunteer at WTLC, a shelter for individuals and families escaping domestic violence or exploitation, A Volunteer Day has been established on the last Thursday of the month from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Volunteers play a vital role in helping WTLC staff maintain a home-like atmosphere for those who enter our programs. Examples of the work volunteers can expect may include: organizing closets and pantries, gardening, facility cleaning, sorting clothing, administrative tasks, and other projects as needed.

Large groups consisting of 15 volunteers or more can be accommodated, but must be arranged in advance.

In order to volunteer directly with WTLC clients, a volunteer must be at least 18 years old and complete a State-mandated 40-hour training. These training sessions are held twice a year.
