July 17, 2014 – One year’s worth of fundraising by the Woman’s Club of Fullerton (WCOF) resulted in the presentation of a check for \$5,000 to benefit the Women’s Transitional Living Center (WTLC).

In 2013, the WCOF named WTLC as its Charity of the Year with proceeds from its “Quartermania” and “Bunco Boogie” fundraisers going to WTLC.
